Next Monday, October 26 we will be taking some 75-80 of our school children to the former St. Anne School building on South Jones St. to help celebrate the historical marker being erected in front of that building. This marker will commemorate St. Anne School for becoming the first school in South Carolina to integrate children. Local dignitaries, our school diocesan superintendent, newspapers, Oratorians, and six Immaculate Heart of Mary (IHM) sisters from Pennsylvania will be in attendance, among many others. The IHM order of sisters helped run St. Anne School for many years and we owe a great deal of gratitude to them for making St. Anne the quality school it is today.

The Touching Safety program lessons will be held in each classroom for all grades K-8 on Wednesday, Oct. 28. These are mandated lessons occurring once a year by the Diocese of Charleston. For the lower grades, the lesson may last about 20 minutes, while in the middle school grades the lesson may last approximately 40 minutes. These lessons are in the school office for you to review if you wish. We also sent opt-out forms in last Thursday's envelopes if you choose not to have your child partake in this lesson; more opt-out forms are available in the office if you need one.
