\$525 was donated from the NUTS day last week to go toward a mission in Guatemala, which assists in providing shelter for those in need.

The following is information from the York County Health Department's plans for H1N1 immunizations –

The Center for Disease Control (CDC) has recommended that certain target groups receive the vaccine immediately as it is available. Those groups include pregnant women, caregivers of children under six months of age, healthcare and emergency medical personnel, those between the ages of six months and 24 years old, and those age 25 through 64 who may be at higher risk due to chronic health issues. Your children fall into one of the target groups.

The York County Health Department will offer an immunization clinic at the health department site at 1070 Heckle Blvd., Rock Hill. This will be held on November 11 from 7:00 to 10:00 am and 3:00 to 7:00 pm, pending vaccine availability. The vaccine will be offered at no charge. Any staff members and parents of these children who fall into any of the target groups may also receive their immunization at this time.

For those children 9 years old and younger, a second vaccine will be needed to offer stronger immunity. Follow-up information will be provided for these children as they receive the initial vaccine.
