As I approach the end of my first year here at St. Anne School, I can see that we have a very good school, but I can also see that we can become even better. I have been working with the teachers in converting the middle school grades to block scheduling for next year; the reason this is taking place is because we feel this will be a good improvement.

As mentioned in a previous Thursday newsletter, we are privileged to be recipients of 15 new Compound Microscopes due in large part to Silvia Wozniak and the donors she solicited (families mentioned last week). These microscopes are equipped with LED lights, stage equipped with Vernier scale battery (allows work not connected to electricity), three powers of magnification 4X, 10X, 40X and a set of mounted slides (all division, plants and animals). The microscopes will nicely enhance and update our science curriculum.

We are looking forward to a great year at St. Anne School next year. For middle school students this brings many changes and milestones as we enter a new phase at our school. In Kindergarten we are adding a reading program.
